1. **BAGGAGE RULES**

A) Carry-on Baggage

- i) Business Class
Two cabin bags (2 pcs) not exceeding 14kgs (30lbs), the total sum of three dimensions of both pieces must not exceed 50 x 30 x 20 cm = 100cm (40 inches)
- ii) Economy/Standard class (Y Class)
One (1) cabin bag (1pc) not exceeding 7kgs (15lbs), the total measurement of which must not exceed 50 x 30 x 20 cm = 100cm (40 inches)

On Air Niugini International and Domestic Flights each passenger may carry, in addition to the free allowance, the under mentioned articles only when retained in the passengers' custody, except item 7 that may be carried in the passenger baggage and cargo compartments of the aircraft.

- i) A lady's handbag, lady's pocket book or lady's purse which is appropriate to normal traveling dress and is not being used as a container for the transportation of articles that would otherwise be regarded as baggage;
- ii) An overcoat, wrap or blanket;
- iii) A small camera or pair of binoculars;
- iv) A reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight;
- v) Infant's food for consumption on flight;
- vi) Infant's basket and;
- vii) A fully collapsible invalid's wheelchair and braces or other prosthetic device for the passengers use; provided that the passenger is dependent upon them.

Any item that purports to be a specified article listed above, but does not visibly conform to the description set out must be weighed and such weight included in the total baggage weight.

All other articles including overnight bags, briefcase, typewriter, personal radios, ladies vanity or cosmetic cases, hat boxes, infant collapsible pram, wheelchairs, heavy cameras and reading matter which cannot reasonably be carried during the flight, must be weighed with the baggage and subjected to normal rules.

These Items must be weighed, and if necessary, charged in accordance with valid tariff. Cabin baggage dimensions vary in different countries and are subject to Government and Airline regulations in force at the time of travel.

B) Checked Baggage Allowance

***Infants** – Less than 2 years of age for Papua New Guinea domestic and International travel.

Infants shall additionally be allowed one checked or carry on fully collapsible stroller/pushchair or infants carry basket or infant's car seat which may be carried in the passenger cabin subject to the availability of space.

Additional Free Baggage

- A fully collapsible wheelchair and/or a pair of crutches if the passenger is dependent on this for both domestic and International travel
- 10kg of any sporting equipment or 15kg of scuba diving equipment may be included in the passenger's free baggage allowance. Weight in excess will be assessed at the applicable excess baggage charges. This allowance also applies to domestic travel in conjunction with international journey, provided that tickets are not issued separately. If international and domestic tickets are issued separately, they must be cross-referenced

There are certain items which you must not include in your baggage:

- Items prohibited by the law or government policies of any state to be flown from or to;
- Items which are likely to endanger the aircraft or persons or property on board the aircraft and are generally considered by Air Niugini to be unsuitable for carriage because they are dangerous or unsafe or by reason of their weight, size, shape or character;
- Perishable or fragile items which include and are not limited to cash, precious metals, jewelry, laptop, camera, mobile phone, I-pad or any other electronic device of value, negotiable papers, business documents or samples, securities or other valuables. Except as provided for under the relevant provisions in 4 and 5, Air Niugini will not be liable for the loss, damage to or delay in the delivery of any fragile or valuable Item/s that are packed as checked baggage whether with or without the knowledge of the airline . We encourage passengers to ensure valuables are taken as hand carry or are on them.

Note:

Please be aware that Storage limitations apply on some Air Niugini operated services. Domestic travel is defined as travel not combined with any international flights. International travel is defined as travel between two or more countries including any flights within those countries when they are combined with any international flights. For International travel, a passenger using Air Niugini connecting services is entitled to the applicable international free baggage allowance. Additional baggage may be carried at a fixed baggage rate per kilogram in excess. An excess fee will be collected for each kilogram of baggage over the designated free baggage allowance and for each piece that is overweight.

C. Interline Journeys.

“Interline” also means “interline travel” that is involving multiple air carriers listed on a single ticket that is purchased via a single transaction.

1. Passengers arriving on **Qantas FLIGHTS** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SPLIT PNR** (No codeshare agreement)
 - **Separate baggage rules. Apply PX Domestic Baggage Allowance**
2. Passengers arriving on **Qantas FLIGHTS** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SAME PNR** (We allow International Allowance)
 - **Apply the term “interline travel” allowance. Apply International Baggage Allowance**
3. Passengers arriving on **Virgin Australia FLIGHTS** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SPLIT PNR** (NO interline agreement/ International allowance NOT guaranteed)
 - **No, there is no interline travel – Apply PX domestic baggage allowance**
4. Passengers arriving on **Virgin Australia FLIGHTS** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SAME PNR** (NO interline agreement/ International allowance NOT guaranteed)
 - **NO interline travel as evident by one ticket, one transaction – Apply PX Domestic baggage allowance**
5. Passengers arriving on **Air Niugini flights** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SPLIT PNR** (We allow international allowance)
 - **This is PX carriers and as own tickets, we can waive separate tickets and allow international baggage to apply. This is not considered “interline”. Its online (within one airline).**
 - **Apply International Baggage allowance**
6. Passengers arriving on **Air Niugini flights** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SAME PNR**
 - **Apply International Baggage Allowance**
7. Passenger arriving on **Philippines Airline flights** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to Any DOMESTIC Port on a **SPLIT PNR** (No codeshare agreement)
 - **Separate baggage rules. Apply PX Domestic Baggage Allowance**
8. Passengers arriving on **Philippines Airlines FLIGHTS** and connecting on **Air Niugini FLIGHTS** to any DOMESTIC Port on **SAME PNR** (We allow International Allowance)
 - **Apply the term “interline travel” allowance. Apply International Baggage Allowance**

2. EXCESS BAGGAGE CHARGES

Air Niugini Limited revised its Excess Baggage Charges effective 1 October 2017. This was to conform with relevant baggage application for the new Passenger Service System (PSS) that came online 30 September 2017. The action that Air Niugini took streamlined baggage applications on its entire network.

The action is adopted IATA 300 (weight concept) however minus the recommended charge rate ("The excess baggage charge per kilogram is 1.5% of the highest normal direct adult one way economy class fare").

Note: For the avoidance of doubt, IATA resolutions are guidelines and recommended practices which carriers can adopt or use to create their own rules to meet its business objective.

The Excess Baggage Charges listed below are applicable on Air Niugini services only and effective from 1 October 2017.

3. PREPAID BAGGAGE

Air Niugini has availed prepaid baggages to the traveling public for those who think their baggage will exceed the allowable checked baggage allowance. Prepaid baggages are purchased in blocks of five kilograms (5kgs) with a minimum of five kilograms (5kgs) and maximum of forty five (45kgs) per passenger. Prepaid baggage is available on Air Niugini's entire network and will be governed by the following:-

- Its available only on Air Niugini operated flights.
- Must be purchased at least three hours (3hrs) before departure at the nearest sales office.
- Pre-paid baggage will not be purchased at check-in; only Excess Baggage is applicable at check-in.
- No single baggage item must exceed 32kgs.
- Prepaid baggage is non-refundable and deemed used when flights departs and corresponding flight coupon status is closed or flown.
- Prepaid baggage is non-transferable.
- If there are residual, no refund will be made.

Note: Passengers must correctly estimate the total weight and must pay the correct amount as once paid, no refund will be allowed.
