It is a corporate policy of Air Niugini to carry out all that is practical to protect the company's employees, passengers, assets and properties entrusted to its care. This is achieved by:

- Complying in all respects with the security regulations and standards of Air Niugini.
- The provision of all resources necessary for the successful implementation of the policy.
- The promotion of Security Awareness and the establishment of a security culture within the organisation.
- The establishment of security objectives and security performance standards.
- Continual improvement of the Security Management System (SeMS).
- Periodic review of the policy to ensure continuing relevance to the organisation.
- Assessing with due diligence all areas of potential security risk prior to commencing operations.
- Establishing robust systems and procedures to enable staff to have the necessary direction and controls to protect the company and its operations.
- Continually assessing possible threats and risks and taking measures to minimize them.
- Monitoring the performance against pre-established security standards.
- Promote a Challenge and Report culture within the organisation

The Air Niugini security objectives will be reviewed regularly for ensuring that security is kept at a high standard. The management team is fully supportive and committed to achieving this goal.
